Le Grand Vin Blanc

Le Grand Vin Blanc 2023 is the first wine produced from these young vines during an atypical vintage. The wine showcases bright acidity with crisp citrus notes. For the best expression of the fruit, we recommend decanting for one hour before serving.

THE ESTATE

Osoyoos Larose 'Le Grand Vin' is the result of centuries-old Bordeaux tradition deployed on exceptional Canadian terroir. In 1998, the renowned French Groupe Taillan established the Osoyoos Larose estate on an 80-acre bench overlooking magnificent Lake Osoyoos in the south Okanagan Valley of British Columbia. While the project originally aimed to create two iconic red wines, Osoyoos Larose expanded its vision in 2020 to produce a white wine. A blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon was planted on the valley floor in deep alluvial gravel soils on 2 acres.

THE VINTAGE

The 2023 vintage was a year of extremes, from the deep freeze of December 2022 to the intense heat of July and August. This volatile weather led to a total loss of production for the estate's red wines and a nearly 75% loss in the whites, making this a very limited and rare release. This is the vineyard's first crop.



ON THE PALATE

Bright, lively acidity lifting taut, crisp notes of fresh citrus — vibrant and energetic from start to finish.

SERVICE

Decant one hour before serving for the fullest expression of the fruit.
